



Ratp Dev takes over the Dunois Voyages Group

On October 26th 2010, Ratp Dev signed the takeover for the Dunois Voyages Group, specialized in urban and interurban transport services in the Centre Region of France.

Based in Orleans, the Dunois Voyages Group also offers tourist trips, school transport services and on-demand services for company personnel and persons with reduced mobility. At present, the group employs 220 persons and its turnover should reach 24 million euros in 2010. Every year, its 170 vehicles transport 145 000 passengers and make about 300 000 school trips.

This acquisition confirms Ratp Dev's ambitions in France, to become the 3rd largest public transport operator. After the takeover of Cars Jacquemard in 2008, it reinforces the presence of the company on interurban networks. Lastly, it provides proof of Ratp Dev's interest in the Centre Region of France, as this takeover precedes the recovery of Veolia and Transdev assets in 2011, which should increase the presence of Ratp Dev even more in this high-potential region.

This operation is subject to agreement by local authorities. Information will be provided to staff representative bodies.
